**Town Roads, Road Improvement Plan-Scott Construction and Lorn looked over:**

1. North Ridge Rd.- from Newton to Dahl driveway ss hard surface \$12,002.00.
2. North Ridge Rd- from Dahl driveway to top of hill ss hard surface \$15,620.00.
3. North Ridge Rd.- from top of hill to newer seal coat line ss hard surface \$39,524.00.
4. North Ridge Rd. from end of newer seal coat to Stockman Ln. ss hard surface \$11,319.00
5. Upper Newton Rd-gravel over the new culvert, double seal gravel surface \$841.00.
6. Sebion Lane-from Cty O to town line ss hard surface \$19,080.00.
7. Miller Lane-from Sebion to the dead end, ss hard surface \$9,052.00

Motion made and seconded by Bauer/Gartner to approve road repair on Roads #3 Thru #7, Grand Total \$79816.00. No Loan Needed. Work to start next week. Motion carried.

Motion made and seconded by Bauer/Gartner to Table the Johnson Quarry (020-00250-0000) Parcel. More information needed, Harmony and Vernon County may own this Tax Exempt Parcel. Motion Carried.
