Vernon County

SECTION 1- PURPOSE

- An ordinance allowing ATV and UTV travel on all Town Roads within the Town of Harmony.

SECTION 11-AUTHORITY

- Under Wisconsin Statute 59.02, and Wisconsin Statute 23.33.

SECTION 111-ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

- The designation of ATV and UTV routes/roads within the Town of Harmony.
- Approved routes/roads shall be marked with the appropriate signage.

SECTION IV-CONDITIONS

- All ATV/UTV Operators must carry liability insurance coverage.
- All ATVs/UTVs must be properly registered with the Dept of Natural Resources prior to operating on any routes.
- All ATV/UTV operators shall observe posted speed limits.
- All ATV/UTV operators shall slow the vehicle to 10-mph or less when operating within 150 feet of a dwelling.
- All ATV/UTV operators shall operate on paved portions of roadway only, in single file on the righthand side of road.
- All ATV/UTV operators shall have headlight/taillight illuminated, and equipped with reflectors.
- All ATV/UTV operators shall be 16 years of age or older.
- All ATV/UTV operators under 18 years of age shall wear protective headgear of the type required by Wisconsin Statute 347.485 (1)(a).
- ATV/UTV operators shall engage in recreational use of routes between 4:00am and 10:00pm only.

SECTION V-ENFORCEMENT

- This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer of the Vernon County Sheriff's Dept, or any other law enforcement official as set forth in Wisconsin Statute 23.33(12).

SECTION VI-PENALTIES

- The Town recognizes all penalties authorized under Wisconsin Statute 23.33 (13) (a).
- The Town reserves the right to alter or discontinue some or all routes for cause. (i.e., complaints and the failure to adhere to the conditions stated in Section IV.

SECTION VII-SEVERABILITY

- Any provisions held invalid will not affect the whole of this ordinance.

SECTION VIII-EFFECTIVE DATE

- Upon proper passage by Town residents and signage by the Town Board.

Copies of this ordinance shall be sent to the Vernon County Sheriff's Department and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. This ordinance will also be posted by the Town Clerk at the Town Hall located at E2905 Newton Road, Genoa, WI. 54632.

This ordinance may be revisited at the annual meeting upon request of the residents or the board to be altered or cancelled by a majority vote of the residents.




We feel by including these County roads which lie within our boundaries would enable ATV/UTV riders to make use of our entire Town road system. Thank-You for considering our request.








